**NOTICE / AGENDA OF COMMISSION DELIBERATION TO TAKE COMMISSION
ACTION ON THE BELOW-INDICATED CASES**

A nonevidentiary deliberation will be held in the below-indicated cases at 11:00 a.m. ET, 10:00 a.m. CT, or as soon thereafter as can be heard on Thursday, January 27, 2022.

ISSUES: The above-indicated Commission Panel will vote on the disposition of each of the below-indicated cases.

AUTHORITY: Sections 120.569, 120.57 and 760.01 to 760.37, Florida Statutes.
